Aswan Dam and Isis Temple

After breakfast Fly to Aswan and visit **Philae Temple**. It was dedicated to the goddess Isis, the wife of Osiris and mother of Horus. These three characters are very important in ancient Egyptian life, culture and art. Then a visit to The High Dam and the Egyptian Cotton Shop. In the afternoon you will lunch aboard a felucca, sailing around Kitchener's Island. Then afterwards depart by motorboat to the Nubian Village. You will depart the boat and take a camel ride through the desert into the Nubian Village where you will get an opportunity to interact with a Nubian family and learn about their simple life style, culture and traditions. **Overnight: Movenpick Resort & SPA**

Day 3: Friday February, 28: Abu Simbel Temples

Abu Simbel Temple

All meals are aboard ship

After breakfast you will depart by bus for Abu Simbel. The two temples in the Abu Simbel complex were carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramesses II, in the 13th century BCE, as a lasting monument to himself and his queen, Nefertari. After that we head back to Aswan, then the Tour staff will transfer you from the Aswan Movenpick hotel to the 5 Star Luxury Nile cruise ship. Lunch on board, In the afternoon you will have the opportunity to enjoy high tea at the Old Cataract hotel and visit the Healing Oil Shop in Aswan. Then back to the Cruise. **Overnight: Nile Cruise Ship Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner**



Day 4: Saturday March, 1: Kom-Ombo and Horus Temples

The ship will set sail. After breakfast you will journey first to **KomOmbo Temple**. The northern half was dedicated to the god Horus and the Southern half to the crocodile god, Sobek. After the tour, you will return to the cruise ship and continue sailing to Edfu. After Lunch enjoy a visit to the **Temple Of Horus** in Edfu. It is one of the best preserved temples in Egypt and was dedicated to the Falconheaded god, Horus. After the tour, we will return to the ship and continue on to Luxor, passing through the Esna Lock. **Overnight: Nile Cruise / Luxor Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner**





Day 5: Sunday March, 2: Karnak and Luxor Temples

Karnak and Luxor Temples

After breakfast you will visit **Karnak Temple**. The temple complex has four parts. The most commonly visited one is the Precinct of Amun-Ra. In addition to this precinct we will visit the three other parts: the Precinct of Mut, the Precinct of Montu, and the ruins of AmenhotepIV. (more commonly known as Ankhenaten.). Then proceed to visit the **Papyrus Shop.** Free time has been built in to enjoy the resort. In the evening (around 6:00 PM) we will visit **Luxor Temple.** This a large ancient temple complex, located on the east bank of the Nile River, and was founded in 1400 BCE. After touring the temple, we will return to the cruise.

Day 6: Monday March, 3: Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut Temple

Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut Temple

After breakfast (by 7:30 AM) we will transfer off the Cruise ship, and journey to the **Valley of the Kings**, including the King Tut tomb. also called the Valley of the Gates of the Kings. For a period of nearly 500 years, from the 16th to11th century BC, tombs were constructed there for the Pharaohs and powerful nobles of the New Kingdom. The valley stands on the west bank of the Nile, opposite Thebes (modern Luxor), within the heart of the Theban Necropolis. followed by a visit to the **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut.** This mortuary temple is dedicated to the sun god Amon-Ra and is located next to the mortuary temple of Mentuhotep II. then check into the Maritim Jolie Ville Luxor Hotel. **Overnight: Luxor / Maritim Jolie Ville Hotel**

Fly to Cairo

Egyptian Museum and Civilization Museum

After breakfast our tour staff will transport you by bus to the Luxor airport, to fly to Cairo. Upon arrival we will visit the Cairo Egyptian Museum. This museum contains many important pieces of ancient Egyptian history and houses the world's largest collection of Pharaonic antiquities. This includes many treasures from the tomb of King Tutankhamen. Then we will go to visit the National museum of Egyptian Civilization. Situated on the summit of a centuries-old citadel, this is a fine example of an Ottoman-era mosque. Then transfer to the Mena House hotel and Overnight. **Overnight: Cairo / Mena House Hotel Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner**



Day 10: Friday March, 7: Memphis / Step Pyramid at Sakkara

Dahshur / Step Pyramid at Sakkara

After breakfast you will visit Dahshur and Saqqara the Pyramid of Djoser. This step pyramid is the archeological remains of the Saqqara necropolis, situated northwest of the city of Memphis. It was built in 27th century BC during the Third dynasty for the burial of Pharaoh Djoser by his vizier, Imhotep. After lunch we will visit the Serapeum of Saqqara. It was a burial place of the sacred Apis bulls that were incarnations of the ancient Egyptian deity Ptah. It was believed that the bulls became immortal after death as did Osiris. Then back to the hotel.

Evening Time there will be an opportunity to have 2 hours of private time inside the Great Pyramid King's Chamber and Queen's





Chamber.

Another unique characteristic of the Temple of Alexander the Great would be the red alter located near the front gate. This alter is made from red granite that is not found anywhere nearby. Then Desert Safari / Hot Springs / **CAMPING in Desert overnight**
